### The Pastor's Heart

Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen. Ephesians 3:20-21 ESV

We have been told that President Trump's first 100 days have concluded as of April 30. What does that mean to the average American? It all depends on which voices that you are listening to and what you want to hear. But isn't that true of life? We hear what we want to hear and actually do what we want to do? But I say . . . there is a better way!

One of the lessons I learned from my mentor was the prayer at the end of Ephesians 3:14-21. This puts into perspective how we are to live life in surrender to Jesus Christ our Lord. I am looking at the above verses at the end of this prayer this month.

We are taught three important lessons in these verses. First, God can do far more than we can ask or think. His thoughts are not our thoughts, and his ways are not our ways according to Isaiah 55:8 (ESV). He can "get things done" when we place ourselves in his control. This is often how I do my job by following the lead of the Spirit of Jesus. God has a plan, a purpose for each one of us. It is a plan that you can trust even if you don't have all the details. Abram was told by God to leave home and get away from his heritage and roots. God didn't share the details, but he proved to be faithful to Abram. See Genesis 12:1ff.

Secondly, God is all-powerful, we call him **omnipotent.** His power works through us! Job 42:2 indicates that his power exceeds our imagination, whatever God wants to accomplish cannot be stopped. His power does not compare to ours, Matthew 19:26 "*But Jesus looked at them and said, With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.*" He chooses to work in and through surrendered followers. He can do amazing things through a life totally committed to Jesus. He reminded his disciples that he would continue to be with them and use them to reach the world. We are the remnant of his followers aligned to reach the world around us.

Lastly, we see from this prayer that we are made to bring him glory. Are you more interested in making a name for yourself? Are you looking for recognition or notice? Our aim as Christ followers is to bring glory to God. Where? First, in the church. We are to love God and love one another and then take this love into the world around us. We are called to serve both in church and in community. We used to call politicians "public servants." Each one of us should look for opportunities to serve the public. When we serve others, it is as though we are serving Christ Jesus himself. See Matthew 25:34-40 ESV. This brings honor and glory to our Lord.

Something else I see in this prayer is that our service, when done according to God's leading and with his power, will not only glorify him today, but we will leave a legacy or a lasting impression on future generations. Do you see that? We can and must have an impact on those who follow in our footsteps. If you were to ask Merna Fraser's children and grandchildren about her influence on their lives, what do you think they would say? Yes, I agree . . . just think, we can have that same impact through Christ our Lord, Amen!


